Monument to the Marian Captain Barberán and Tros and the Lieutenant Joachim Necklace Serra: Dedicated obelisk to honor heroes of the flight to the Spanish pilots Seville Camaguey the June 11, 1933, to the 3:30pm (local time) the biplane gets to our appropriate city of Seville the four Vientos which tried to reprint in an aerial raid without precedents the way of the Gran Almirante Cristóbal Colón.

That the broadest Atlantic part implied transiting had like first purpose the one of experiencing the difficulties and according to the results, systematizing his job in the future. The second purpose consisted in a cultural and affective approach between Spain and Latin America, particularly with Cuba and Mexico. Aviators were welcomed in the Hotel Camaguey, present-day Museo Provincial Ignacio Agramonte, for the Warlord of the Province, from where they greeted the town of intervening Cuba the local broadcasting station CMJK the voice of the camagüeyano. They visited several places of the city and a decree signed by the Mayor pronouncing them Guests Of Honor of the City of Camaguey, as well as brasses of the flight done in precious wood and silver was delivered to them.
